From 1987 to 2002, she served as Officer at the Banking Supervision Department of the Bank of Italy.

She has been Visiting Researcher at Harvard Law School (Cambridge (MA)).

She is author of more than 60 articles (papers and books contributions) and 4 books in the fields of banking and financial regulation, commercial law and financial contracts.
