

Prof. Dr. Filippo Zatti

Filippo Zatti holds a PhD in Public Economic Law at Sapienza University of Rome and is an associate professor of Economic Law at the Department of Economics and Management at the University of Florence. He is Professor of Diritto bancario e del mercato finanziario and economic law at the School of Economics and Management at the same university. He is also head of a training course in Economics and Law of Digital Assets (ELDA).

He is the Scientific Coordinator of a research unit, BABEL-Blockchains and Artificial Intelligence for Business, Economics and Law, and the University of Florence responsible for the cooperative agreement with Consob, the Italian capital market regulatory authority.

Co-head of the "Law and Economic Regulation Studies" series, he is one of the referees of the Italian Journal of Financial and Insurance Market Law.

Together with the EBI-European Banking Institute fellowship, he is also an Individual Fellow of the European Law Institute (ELI) and the Digital Euro Association (DEA). He is a member of the Italian Association of Economic Law Professors (ADDE) and the Italian Society for Law and Economics (ISLE).

INATBA (International Association for Trusted Blockchain Applications) invited him to join the Academic Advisory Board and the Italia4Blockchain Association as a member of the Governing Board. He is also involved in the CifrisChain initiative and was appointed to the Blockchain Education Network Italia Steering Committee.

He was a visiting PhD student at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies in London. Recently, the School of Law at the University of Edinburgh invited him to the visiting scholar program, where he could temporarily join the Blockchain Technology Laboratory.

His research focuses primarily on the relationship between law and technology innovation in banking, capital markets, and financial system regulation. More precisely, he is committed to studying the legal nature and governance of CBDCs and cryptoassets from the perspective of an adequate and comprehensive regulatory framework, particularly at the European level.
