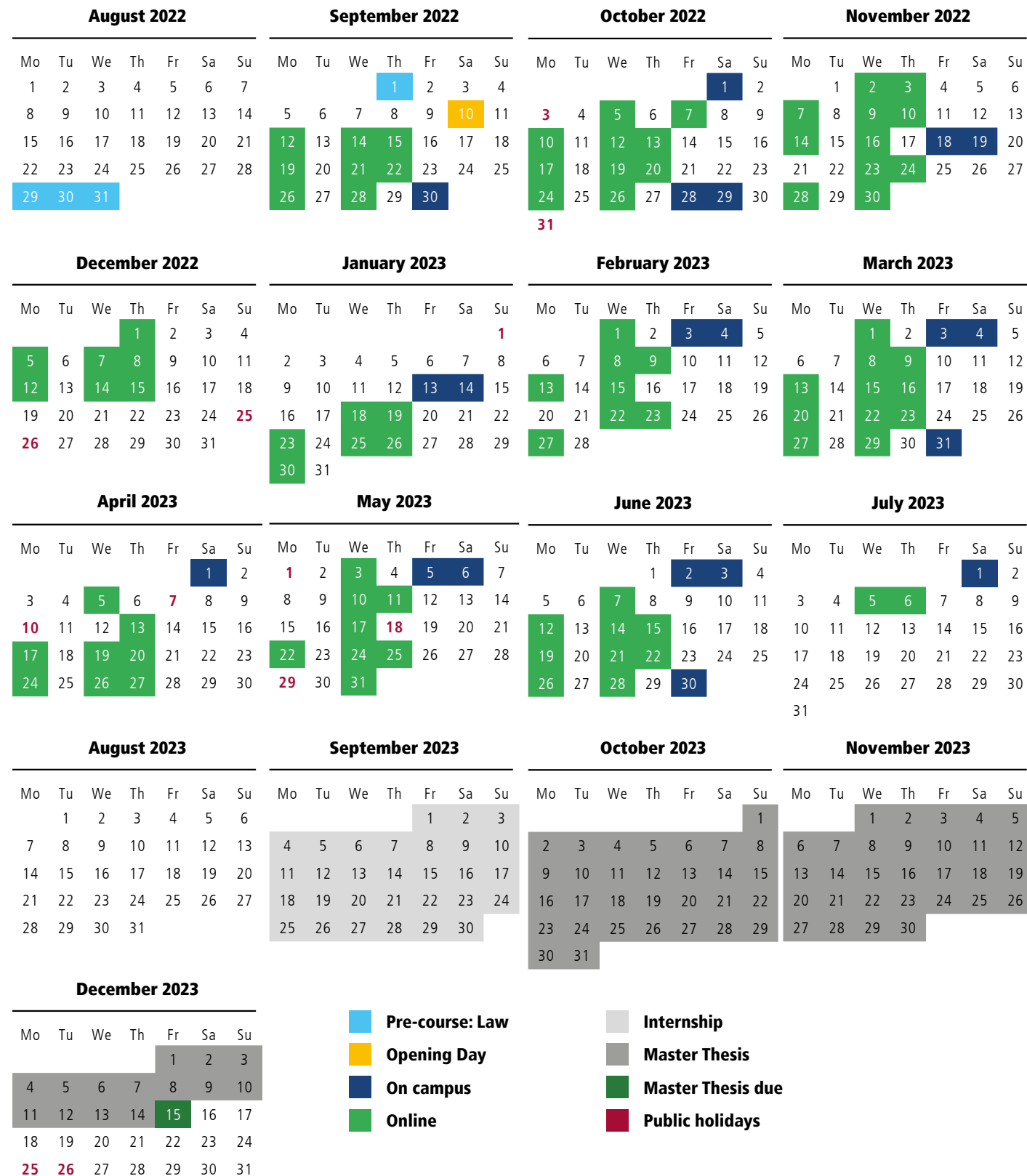


EBI MASTER IN EU BANKING & FINANCIAL REGULATION 2022-2023



Study Model

Students will attend class in-person on the FS Campus approximately one weekend each month, while also participating in three online evening courses each week for the remainder of the month.

Online evening classes are scheduled 17:00 – 21:00 CET/CEST, including a break.

On-campus courses will be all day on campus. Hybrid participation is available for those who cannot travel to Frankfurt, though in-person participation is greatly encouraged.

Pre-course: Law

Students without previous experience in law will be required to take a pre-course in law. The lessons will be online from 17:00 – 21:00 CET/CEST. There are no additional costs or fees for the pre-course.
