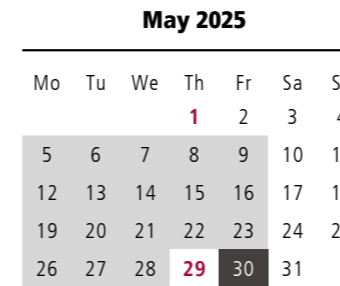
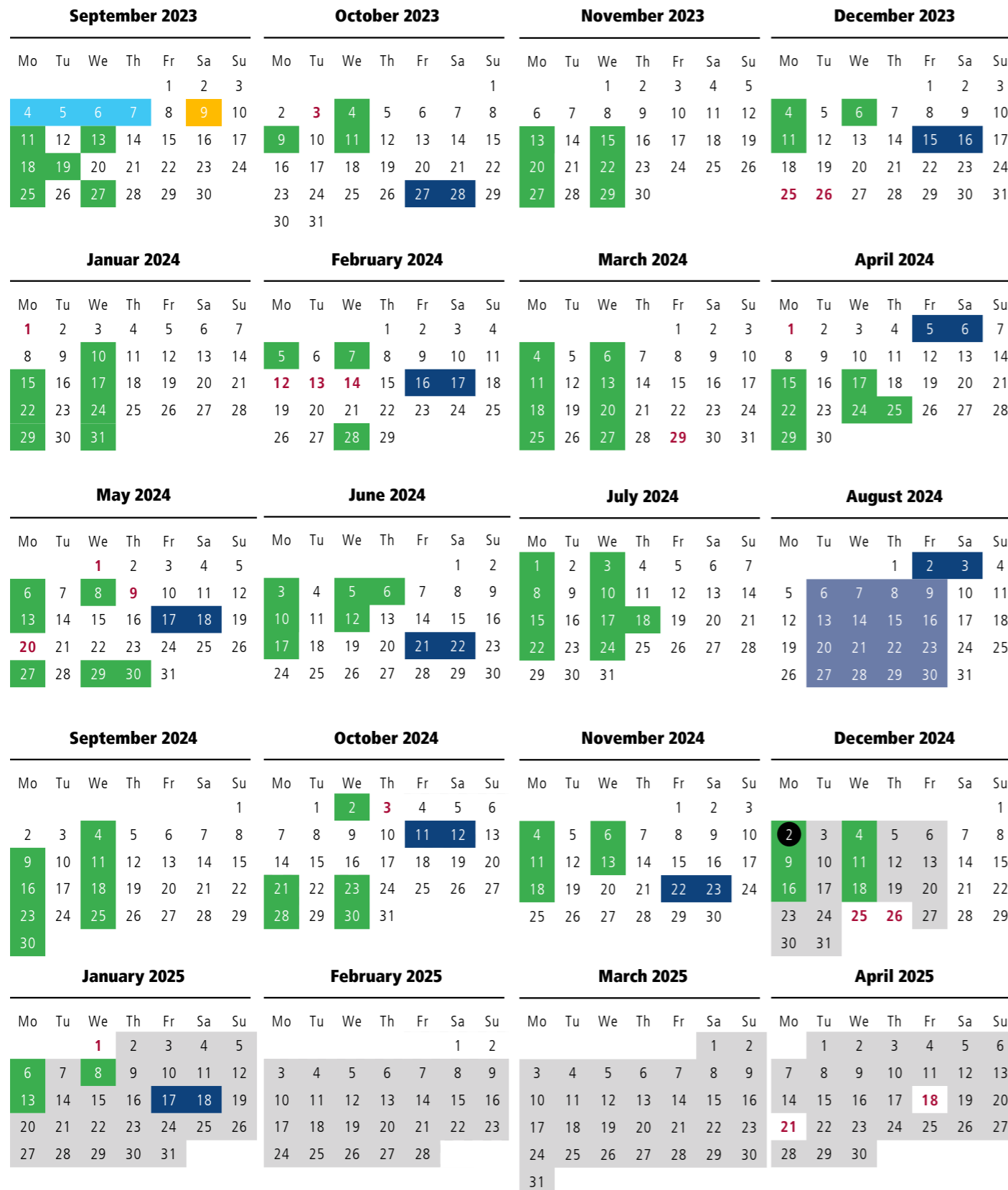


MASTER IN EU BANKING & FINANCIAL REGULATION (EBI) 2023-2025

Study Model

Students will attend class in-person on the FS Campus approximately one weekend or on an alternate month, while also participating in two (occasionally 3) online evening courses in each module.

Online evening classes are scheduled 17:00 – 20:30 CET/CEST, including a break. On-campus courses will be all day and take place on the Frankfurt Campus. For students who cannot travel to campus, we will continue to offer hybrid options for remote participation. Students will have a month of summer break in August. Students will have 8 mandatory core modules and select 2 electives out of the 4 offered.

Pre-course: Law

Students without previous experience in law will be required to take a pre-course in law. The lessons will be online from 17:00 – 20:30 CET/CEST. There are no additional costs or fees for the pre-course.
