

## **Anita Pavković**

Anita Pavković is a Full Professor with tenure. She graduated from the Faculty of Economics and Business in 1998 with a degree in Finance, and in 2003 she completed a Postgraduate Study Program in Accounting, Revision and Finance.

In December 2007, she successfully completed her PhD dissertation, entitled "The Influence of Asset Securitization on Financial System Development". Since 1999, she has been employed at the Faculty of Economics and Business in Zagreb, and since February 2024 she has been a full professor – tenured at the Department of Finance. Professor Pavković is a Course Coordinator for courses "Banking" at the Professional Specialist Graduate Programme, "Bank Management" at the University Integrated Programme, "Regulation and Supervision of the Financial Sector" at the University Integrated Programme and participates as a lecturer in other courses on postgraduate and doctoral levels at Universities in Croatia and visiting professor abroad (Spain, Chechia).

Professor Pavković has participated in over 30 international scientific conferences and is the author or co-author of more than 60 scientific papers and over 40 professional and other publications. She has undertaken professional visits to reputable financial institutions and markets worldwide. Professor Pavković has provided mentorship and served on numerous committees for PhD, MSc, Specialist postgraduate programme, MA and BA theses.

From 2014 to 2018, she occupied the position of vice-dean for Business Processes and Administration at the Faculty of Economics and Business, and from 2022 to 2024 she served as the Chair of the Department of Finance. She is the Editor-in-Chief of the Proceedings of the Faculty of Economics and Business Zagreb, the faculty's journal, and she serves as a reviewer for various scientific and professional journals and books. In 2015, she was awarded the Deans' Recognition of the Faculty of Economics and Business in Zagreb in recognition of her work as vice-dean for Business Processes and Administration. She has also obtained professional certificates in banking, finance, innovation, securitization, supervision, and related fields.

Professor Pavković initiated a five-year commercial project "Bank Academy", designed for final-year students, which has garnered significant acclaim within the professional community. Since 2017, she has been a member of the Auditing Board of the National Bank of Croatia, as well as the Supervisory Board of the Commercial Bank and Settlement and Clearing Authority.

In 2024, Professor Pavković edited the book entitled: "Banks and banking: trends and challenges".
